**Dover High School** is participating in "I Am College Bound/I Applied" which aims to increase the number of high school seniors submitting college applications as part of the state's "I Am College Bound" month celebration in November.

On **November, 17<sup>th</sup>** seniors will have the opportunity to submit at least one college admissions application with the assistance of representatives from admissions offices from various NH colleges and universities during the school day at **Dover High School**. As part of the initiative, students receive information about the additional components of a college application, college financial aid process and filing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form. Students will also be eligible to win a \$500 college scholarship for participating in the program. Parent/Guardian permission is required to participate in the event (see attached permission slip). The deadline to sign-up is Nov. 3<sup>rd</sup> in Guidance.

We have our first BIG local scholarship listed in the Guidance Office on the Scholarship Wall. It is called the **Walter and Pauline Calderwood Foundation Scholarship** and it is geared for students who live in Strafford County, who are in need of financial aid in order to attend either 2 or 4-year colleges. Awards range from \$2,000-\$5,000. This is an amazing scholarship opportunity and this foundation will also renew the award for up to four years during college. Stop by the Guidance Office to pick up an application.

## **Transportation- Parent Drop Off**

We encourage students to take the bus and car pool to alleviate traffic and delays due to the volume of traffic in the area around morning drop off and afternoon dismissal. Our close proximity to the Dover Middle School and the limited ability of the infrastructure to handle the volume of traffic present at these times makes travel through the Durham Road/Route 108 and Bellamy Road corridors difficult at best. This situation will at times be compounded by the construction of the new school even though every effort will be made to limit construction related travel during arrival and dismissal times. If you are dropping your students off and/or picking them up, we ask that you use Parking Lot A (not the bus access road) in front of the school or the Alternative School Lot located across the street. We also ask you to note that both of these parking lots have one-way traffic patterns. For Parking Lot A, the entrance is on the Durham Road/Route 108 end of the lot and the exit is on the Bellamy Road end of the lot. For the Alternate School Lot, the entrance is on the Bellamy Road end of the lot and the exit is on the Durham Road/Route 108 end of the lot.
