We want to welcome everyone back from break and send our best wishes for a Happy New Year!

Semester One Exams will be held from January 17th to January 20th. Exams run from 7:40 am to 9:45 am and 10:00 am to 12:00 pm. Morning bus runs do not change and the afternoon buses depart at 12:15 pm. The cafeteria is open for breakfast (7:10 am to 7:40 am), snacks (9:45 am to 10:00 am) and a Grab and Go Lunch will be available at 12:00 pm. If school is canceled the exams scheduled for the day that was canceled will be held the day students return. For example, Block 1 and 2 White Day exams are to be held on January 17. If school was canceled that day those exams would be held on January 18 and the schedule slides forward with additional exam days added as needed. In the case of a two-hour delay, both exams will be held with dismissal taking place at 2:30 pm. Students who do not have an exam do not have to be in school. However, for students who need to stay for the whole morning, the cafeteria will be open and supervised as a study hall.
