Dover High School is participating in "I Am College Bound/I Applied" which aims to increase the number of high school seniors submitting college applications as part of the state's "I Am College Bound" month celebration in November. All New Hampshire colleges will be free to apply to that day and select Early Action deadlines have been extended for some NH schools to the 16th.
