

# 2018 Senior Yearbook Photo Requirements

The DHS Administration has set the following guidelines for Senior Yearbook Photos. These suggestions are also provided as tips from professional photographers for the most flattering and timeless photos.

Remember you can choose your own style and poses for your senior package but the following must be used for your *Senior Yearbook Photo*:

1. Color, glossy, or black and white photos may be submitted. If you are handing in a “hard copy” of a photo be sure the photo has not been folded. All senior photos will be printed in color in the yearbook. If you wish to have the “hard copy” photograph returned to you **please provide a self-addressed stamped envelope.**
2. Please do not use cell phone cameras which have poor resolution.
3. Submit at least a 2.5 x 2.5” photo. Larger photos will be scanned to size.
4. If e-mailing your photo, please submit it in “jpeg” format as an attachment. **If it is not an attachment it will not be accepted.**
5. All photos received via e-mail will receive a response to the e-mail which will serve as confirmation that the photo has been received. If your photographer e-mails your photo, the e-mail confirmation will be sent to the photographer.
6. If a senior does not submit a Senior Photo, the school picture taken on school photo day will be used in the yearbook. If there was no school photo taken by the school photographer the student’s name will appear in the Yearbook as “not pictured”.
7. No hats or props are allowed.
8. Avoid clothing with writing.
9. Show distinction between you and the background.
